5.Proposition 68 Well 6 Water Treatment Plant

The project is closed with the State.

Operation of the facilities are now under the Caruthers CSD budget. The replacement static mixer has been installed and water treatment operations have resumed. Monitoring of the operation has been initiated, and test results have been submitted to the State. Staff is working to resolve any remaining loose ends with the facilities.

6.Proposition 68 Drinking Water Construction Grant for New Well No. 7

Construction is in progress. Site work is nearly complete. Final electrical, and startup activities have commenced. Construction completion and hand over to CCSD is planned for March 2025.

Recommended Action: Board's pleasure.

7.ARPA West Side Tank Project

Bid opening was on January 16, 2025. Bids exceed the current funding amount by over \$700,00. A request was submitted to the County to increase funds, and an inquiry was submitted to the State about possible funding to help with this shortfall. No additional funds are available.

The project plans have been updated to reduce construction costs, and the project is being re-bid. The bid opening is scheduled for March 27, 2025.

8.Drinking Water Planning Grant for Well 3 & 5 TCP Treatment

90% Design for TCP treatment at Well 5 is complete.

A construction funding application has been submitted for TCP treatment at Well 5.

Additional Environmental Review has been requested by the State to move forward with review of the funding application. This work has been initiated.
