5.Proposition 68 Well 6 Water Treatment Plant

Operation of the facilities are now under the Caruthers CSD budget. Monitoring of the operation has been initiated, and test results have been submitted to the State. Staff is working to resolve any remaining loose ends with the facilities.

The State has issued a Return to Compliance letter, stating that the water system has been returned to compliance for arsenic as of April 2025.

Recommended Action: Board's Pleasure.

6.Proposition 68 Drinking Water Construction Grant for New Well No. 7

Construction is in progress. Final electrical and startup activities have commenced.

CCSD has collected samples for Title 22 testing and is awaiting final results.

The well Bacti test was positive for coliform. The contractor disinfected the well on May 1.

Once the Title 22 results and clear Bacti results are obtained, final electrical and startup activities can be completed.

Recommended Action: Board's pleasure.

7.ARPA West Side Tank Project

Bid opening was on March 27, 2025. A Notice of Award was issued to Hartzell.

The pre-construction meeting is scheduled for May 7, 2025.

Recommended Action: Board's Pleasure

8.Drinking Water Planning Grant for Well 3 & 5 TCP Treatment

90% Design for TCP treatment at Well 5 is complete.

A construction funding application has been submitted for TCP treatment at Well 5.

The State has issued a Return to Compliance letter, stating that the water system has been returned to compliance for TCP as of April 2025, since Well 5 has had non-detect levels of TCP since 2023.

Recommended Action: Board's Pleasure

9.Cross Connection Control Program

A Cross Connection Control Plan is due by July 1, 2025. P&P is reviewing the requirements for Small Community Water System (201-999 connections) Cross Connection Control Plan, and will provide recommendations for completing this by the next meeting.
